*The University of Mannheim semester runs from January to May including 1 week orientation program, followed by a 2 1/2 month internship until the start of the fall semester at UConn. It requires students to start the internship while returning to the University to take final exams on certain days in early June (the exam period at German universities typically is 2 to 3 weeks). The sixth semester at any of the other German Universities within Baden-Wuerttemberg requires that students start with the 3 month internship (January to March) followed by study abroad (April to end of July), followed by exams until early/mid August.

**Students receive 6 German credits for the 6 month internship, while they receive only 3 credits for the 3 month internship (1 credit per month of internship).
